### Deuteronomy 7:6-26 (New American Standard)

**6** "For you are a holy people to the Lord your God; the Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for His own possession out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth. **7** The Lord did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any of the peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples, **8** but because the Lord loved you and kept the oath which He swore to your forefathers, the Lord brought you out by a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. **9** Know therefore that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God, who keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments; **10** but repays those who hate Him to their faces, to destroy them; He will not delay with him who hates Him, He will repay him to his face. **11** Therefore, you shall keep the commandment and the statutes and the judgments which I am commanding you today, to do them.

**12** "Then it shall come about, because you listen to these judgments and keep and do them, that the Lord your God will keep with you His covenant and His lovingkindness which He swore to your forefathers. **13** And He will love you and bless you and multiply you; He will also bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your herd and the young of your flock, in the land which

He swore to your forefathers to give you. **14** You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall be no male or female barren among you or among your cattle. **15** And the Lord will remove from you all sickness; and He will not put on you any of the harmful diseases of Egypt which you have known, but He will lay them on all who hate you. **16** And you shall consume all the peoples whom the Lord your God will deliver to you; your eye shall not pity them, neither shall you serve their gods, for that would be a snare to you.

**17** "If you should say in your heart, 'These nations are greater than I; how can I dispossess them?' **18** you shall not be afraid of them; you shall well remember what the Lord your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt: **19** the great trials which your eyes saw and the signs and the wonders and the mighty hand and the outstretched arm by which the Lord your God brought you out. So shall the Lord your God do to all the peoples of whom you are afraid. **20** Moreover, the Lord your God will send the hornet against them, until those who are left and hide themselves from you perish. **21** You shall not dread them, for the Lord your God is in your midst, a great and awesome God. **22** And the Lord your God will clear away these nations before you little by little; you will not be able to put an end to them quickly, lest the wild beasts grow too numerous for you. **23** But the Lord your God shall deliver them before you, and will throw them into great confusion until they are destroyed. **24** And He will deliver their kings into your hand so that you shall make their name perish from under heaven; no man will be able to stand before you until you have destroyed them. **25** The graven images of their gods you are to burn with fire; you shall not covet the silver or the gold that is on them, nor take it for yourselves, lest you be snared by it, for it is an abomination to the Lord your God. **26** And you shall not bring an abomination into your house, and like it come under the ban; you shall utterly detest it and you shall utterly abhor it, for it is something banned.
